The directors and staff will promote a culture of continuous environmental improvement throughout the activities of the business.

Bartington Instruments will take all steps within its power to meet its responsibilities by working to systematic procedures based on the requirements of BS EN ISO 14001:2015.

The Company's Environmental Objectives are reducing the environmental impact through:

In order that these objectives can be achieved, it is a formal requirement that all employees comply with the Company Handbook and Workshop Procedures. Compliance with, and effectiveness of, the Environmental System will be checked through a formal audit program and the annual Environmental System review meeting.
